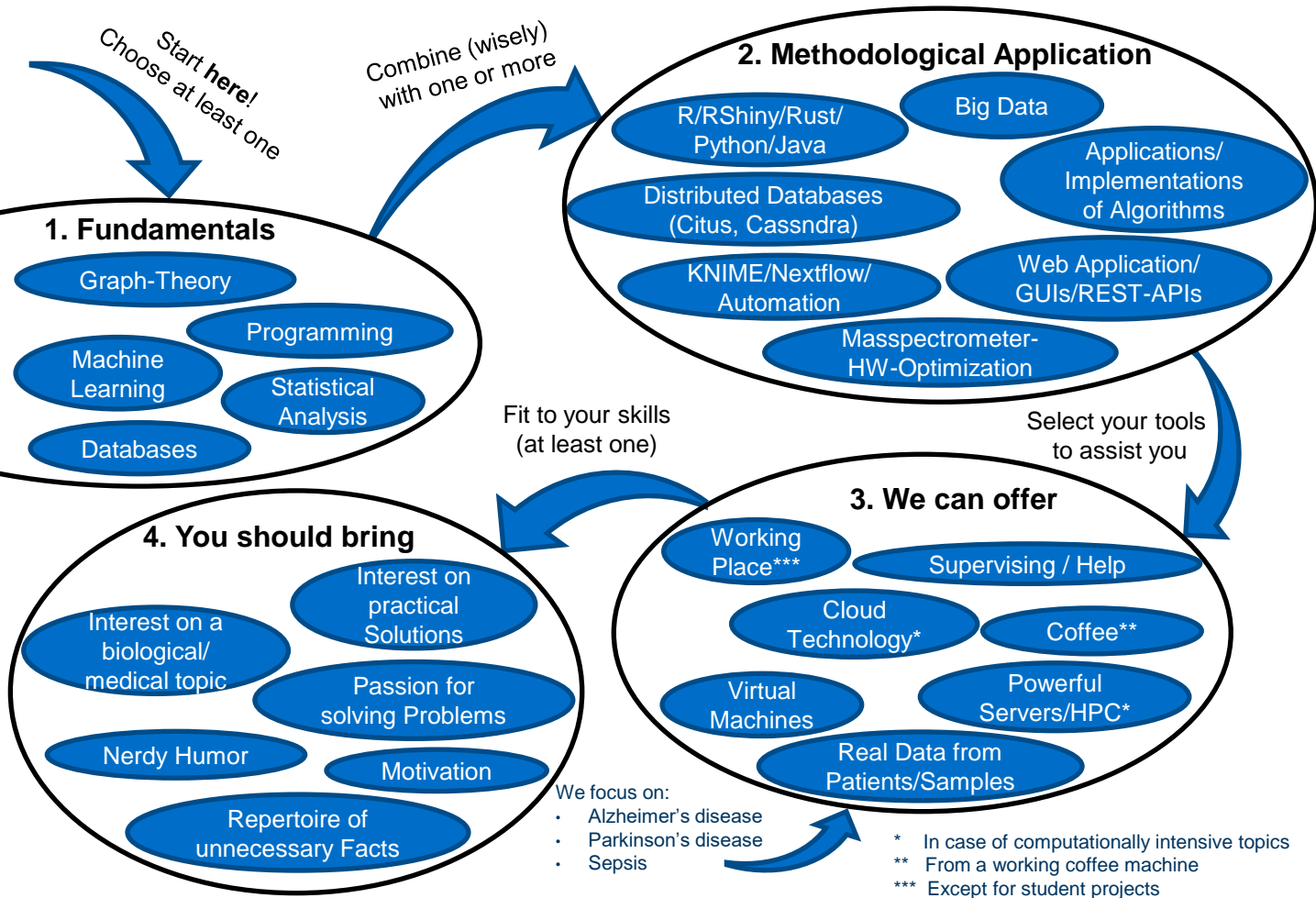


We offer Bachelor's/Master's theses, student projects and internships
