research assistant in tectonics/structural geology

Applicants must hold a diploma/MSc and a doctoral degree in geosciences, preferably in the field of tectonics/structural geology. **Knowledge and experience in one of the following fields is of advantage:** (1) numerical modelling of tectonics and surface processes, (2) neotectonics/palaeoseismology and/or (3) quantification of surface processes using GIS-based or analytical methods (e.g. cosmogenic nuclides). The duties of the successful applicant will include fundraising for his/her own research projects and teaching, primarily on BSc-level (structural geology, geological mapping, field courses).

Payment will be according to the German financial level TV-L 13 (100%). The Leibniz University is an equal opportunity employer. Applications from female candidates are explicitly welcome. In cases of equal qualification and expertise of the applicants, female applicants will be given preference, unless there are preponderant reasons to give preference to another applicant.
